while Section 35(3) (b) of the County Government Act requires a CECM

appointee to be a holder of a degree from a university recognized in Kenya; **FURTHER AWARE**, that Kitui County Assembly Standing Order No. 184 establishes the Appointments Committee mandated to vet County Executive Committee Members (CECMs) for approval by the County Assembly; **RECALLING that**, the Committee vetted and recommended for approval members of the Kitui County Executive Committee which membership was subsequently approved by the House based on the Committee's recommendations;

THIS HOUSE HEREBY RESOLVES to mandate the Committee on Appointments to:

- Inquire into the authenticity of the academic qualifications of all the Kitui
 CECMs as submitted during vetting and verify the same with the relevant
 institutions;
