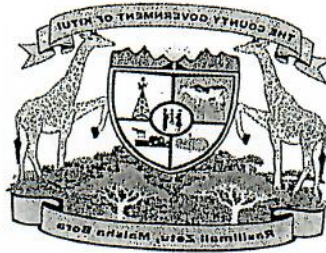

## 2.0 LIST OF NOMINEES FOR MEMBERS OF COUNTY EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

Mr. Speaker Sir,

### 2.1 Appointment Process of County Executive Committee Nominees

In accordance with the provisions of Article 179(2) (b) of the Constitution, H.E. the Governor of Kitui County Hon. Charity.K.Ngilu forwarded the nomination of eight (8) persons vide a letter dated 4<sup>th</sup> October,2017 for vetting by the Committee on Appointments and consideration for approval by the County Assembly for appointment as County Executive Committee members for various Departments. . The Speaker did report the receipt of the notification to the County Assembly on Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> October,2017 (Afternoon Sitting) in line with section 7(1) of the Public Appointments

(County Assemblies Approval) Act no.5 of 2017 following which, the notification stood committed to the appointment committee for vetting (Approval hearing).

### 2.2 Legal Requirements:

The committee on appointments while vetting each of the nominees for appointment of members to the executive committee was guided by the Constitution; the County Governments Act; The Public Appointments (County Assemblies Approval) Act and the Standing Orders amongst traditions and other statutes.

Article 179 (2)(b) of the constitution states that: \_

The County Executive Committee consists of members appointed by the county governor; with the approval of the assembly, from among persons who are not members of the assembly. The number of members appointed under Article 179 (2)(b) above shall not exceed: \_ one third of the number of members of the county assembly, if the assembly has less than thirty members; or Ten, if the assembly has thirty or more members.

The committee considered section 35(2) of the County Governments Act which states as follows:

The county assembly shall not approve nominations for appointment to the executive committee that do not take into account—

- (a) not more than two thirds of either gender;
- (b) representation of the minorities, marginalized groups and communities; and
- (c) community and cultural diversity within the county.

### 3.0 THE VETTING OF THE NOMINEES:

#### Criteria for Vetting

Mr. Speaker Sir,

In conducting the vetting process, the Committee on Appointments examined the nominees against the following criteria, amongst others, as set out in the First Schedule of the Public Appointments (County Assemblies Approval) Act, 2017, :-

- (i) Academic qualifications
- (ii) Employment record
- (ii) Professional affiliations
- (iv) Potential conflict of interest
- (v) Knowledge of the relevant subject
- (vi) Overall suitability for the position
- (vi) Integrity
- (vi i) Vision and leadership
- (ix) Expectations and key priorities

Section 8 of the Public Appointments (County Assemblies Approval) Act, 2017, provides that; the issues for consideration by the relevant House in relation to any nomination shall be: .

- (a) the procedure used to arrive at the nominee;
- (b) any constitutional or statutory requirements relating to the office in question; and
- (c) the suitability of the nominee for appointment proposed having regard to whether the nominee's credentials, abilities, experience and qualities meet the needs of the body to which nomination is being made.

Further, Section 7(12) of the Public Appointments (County Assemblies Approval) Act, 2017, provides that a candidate may at any time, by notice in writing addressed to the Clerk withdraw from the approval process and the candidate's nomination shall thereupon lapse. However, none of the nominees withdrew from the exercise.

Mr. Speaker Sir,

The committee did comply with section 7 of the Public Appointments (County Assemblies Approval) Act in terms of notification to candidates on time and place for approval hearing in addition to inviting the public memoranda on the suitability of the candidates and or personal attendance of the hearing sessions. Mr. Speaker Sir, the members of the public did attend the approval hearing sessions.

#### 4.) THE VETTING PROCESS

Mr. Speaker Sir,

The committee interviewed the nominees on Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> October, through Tuesday 24<sup>h</sup> October, 2017 from 10.00am as outlined in the timetable below.






**THAT**, none of them has ever been dismissed from office for contravention of the provisions of Article 75 of the Constitution which deals with conduct of state officers, that have never been adversely mentioned in any investigatory report of County Assembly or any Commission of Inquiry.

**THAT**, they exhibited impressive knowledge of topical and legal issues touching on their respective dockets and that they have the requisite abilities, qualifications and experience and therefore, the Committee found the nominees suitable for appointment as the County Executive Committee Members.

The Committee therefore recommends that all the eight nominees be approved by the assembly for subsequent appointments to their respective dockets.
