The Clerk of the County Assembly (Mr. Mutambuki): Hon. Members, Standing Order No.3 (2) (b)) further requires that on the first sitting of a new County Assembly, pursuant to the notification under Standing Order No. 3(1) which I have just read, the Clerk shall:"Lay a list of the names of the persons elected as Members on the Table of the County Assembly;"

Hon. Members, it is also important to observe that Section 7(a) (1) of the County Governments Act, (revised edition) provides that a County Assembly shall not be fully and dully constituted for the first sitting after the general election unless all the members provided for under paragraph (b) and (c) of Article 177(1) of the Constitution have been dully nominated and their names published in the gazette.

Hon. Members, I will now read and thereafter proceed to lay the gazette notices on the Table of the Assembly. Notice No. 8239 and dated 22nd August 2017 lists the names of persons elected as Members of the County Assembly from all the County's 40 wards while No. 8380 is for Members nominated by political parties to represent different interests in the County Assembly.

COMMUNICATION FROM THE CLERK OF THE COUNTY ASSEMBLY

PROCEDURE TO BE FOLLOWED IN ADMINISTRATION OF OATH OR AFFIRMATION OF OFFICE

The Clerk of the County Assembly (Mr. Mutambuki) Hon. Members, Standing Order No. 3(2)(c) requires that on the first sitting of a new County Assembly, pursuant to the Governor's notification under Standing Order 3(1), the Clerk shall administer the Oath or Affirmation of Office provided for in the first schedule of the County Governments Act, No. 17, of 2012 to all Members present in the County Assembly, in the order set out in Standing Order No. 3(3).

Standing Order No.3 (3) provides as follows:-

"The Clerk shall administer the Oath or Affirmation of Office to Members in Alphabetical order using the following order of precedence-

- (a) Members with the longest cumulative period of service in the Assembly;
- (b) Members with the longest cumulative period of service in the County Assembly and any local authority existing prior to the final announcement of all the results of Parliament as contemplated under section 2 of the Sixth Schedule to Constitution
- (c) Members with the longest cumulative period of service in any local authority existing prior to the final announcement of all the results of Parliament as contemplated under Section 2 of the Sixth Schedule to the Constitution.

Hon. Members, I also bring to your attention the provision of Standing Order No.3 (4) which states that "Pursuant to Article 74 of the Constitution, no person shall assume or perform any functions of the office of a Member before taking and subscribing to the Oath or Affirmation of Office provided for under paragraph (1)."

Hon. Members, Standing Order No.3 (5) further provides:-

"When the Clerk is administering the Oath or Affirmation of Office to Members and before the Clerk has administered the Oath or Affirmation of Office to the Speaker, any question arising in the Assembly shall be determined by the Clerk who shall, during that period, exercise the powers of the Speaker."

Hon. Members, in line with the Standing Order No. 3(1)(2)(c) I shall now proceed to administer the Oath or Affirmation of office to all Members here present in the order of precedence that is set out in the Standing Order No. 3 (2). In order to facilitate this process, I will give directions on how you will undertake the exercise.

Hon. Members, the name of each Member of the Assembly shall be called out and when called the Member shall come to the podium where I am standing and hereupon shall have the option to take the Oath or Affirmation of Office either in English or Kiswahili as they may

choose and in accordance with their respective religious persuasions.

Hon. Members, after taking the Oath or Affirmation of Office, the Member shall proceed to subscribe to the same by signing the Oath or Affirmation Book at the Table on the left side of where I am standing. I am sure you are ready and we can start the exercise now. I ask the Clerksat-the-Table call out the first name.
