As you are aware, this House approved the motion on realignment of County Assembly Committees on 7th October, 2020. However a Court Order was issued on 14th October, 2020 (Kitui HEC petition no. EO2 of 2020 Josephine Kavivi Mutie and others vs County Assembly of Kitui), which directed that there be a stay of implementation of the resolution of the house of 7th October, 2020 until the hearing of the petition is finalized.
