COMMUNICATION AS RELATES TO THE ISSUES RAISED IN THE REPORT ON THE SUPPLEMENTARY BUDGET ESTIMATES 1, 2021/2022 REGARDING THE PAYMENT OF PENDING BILLS.

Honourable Members,

As you are aware, the House unanimously approved the Supplementary Budget Estimates 1, for the financial year 2021/2022 yesterday.

This morning however, a debate ensued on the floor of the House regarding some sections of the approved Budget and Appropriations Committee's report on the supplementary budget estimates.

The honourable members noted with concern that the report recommended the payment of pending bills to some contractors but not all. This issue was extensively debated this morning and I directed that I will issue a ruling on the same.

Honourable Members,

In light of the weighty issues raised during the debate and upon comprehensive consultations, I direct that this Assembly moves a motion to expunge from the report by the committee on budget and appropriations on consideration of the Supplementary Budget Estimates 1 2021/2022;
