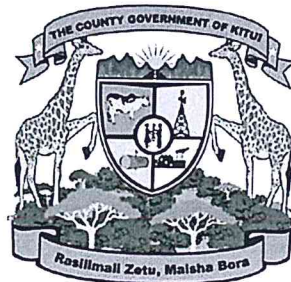

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CHAIRPERSON'S FOREWORD

Mr. Speaker Sir,

This report contains the proceedings of the Committee on Health and Sanitation during the vetting of:

1. **Miss. Lynn Kitwan**, nominee for appointment as the Chief Officer, Department of Public Health and Sanitation;
2. **Dr. Musyoka Benson Wambua**, nominee for appointment as the Chief Officer, Department of Medical Services; and
3. **Mr. Aggrey Kinyalili Kamba**, nominee for appointment as the Chief Officer, Department of Drugs and Medical Supplies;

as submitted by His Excellency the Governor, and communicated to the House by the Speaker on 16th January 2023.

Pursuant to section 45 of the County Governments Act (CGA) and section 6 of the Public Appointments (County Assemblies Approval) Act (hereinafter referred to as the Act), the Governor notified the County Assembly of the nomination of twenty-six (26) Chief Officers for appointment to various County Departments vide a letter dated 19th December, 2022. The Hon. Speaker through a communication made on 16th January, 2023 informed the House of the Governor's nomination and referred the names of the nominees to the Committee for vetting and approval hearings.

In compliance with Article 196(1)(b) of the Constitution, and section 7(5) of the Act, the Clerk of Assembly placed an advert in print media on 23rd January, 2023, informing the public of the nomination, date, time and place for the approval hearings and also invited them to submit memorandum through written statements on oath (affidavits) on the suitability of the

nominees on or before 26th January, 2023. As at close of the submission deadline, the Committee had not received any memoranda.

The Speaker also wrote to the Kenya Revenue Authority (KRA), Higher Education Loans Board (HELB), Office of the Registrar of Political Parties (ORPP), Official Receiver, Universities attended by the nominees, Kenya National Examination Council (KNEC), Metropol CRB Ltd and TransUnion CRB Ltd, seeking background checks relating to the nominees.

The nominees appeared before the Committee on 31st January, 2023 for vetting and their suitability was examined based on the criteria in section 8 of the Act. In addition, the Committee examined their academic credentials, relevant experience, knowledge of sector issues and integrity.

The Committee also examined the procedure used to arrive at the nominees for appointment, constitutional and statutory requirements relating to the office in question and suitability of the nominees having regard to whether their abilities, experience and qualities meet the needs of the respective departments.

Committee observations and recommendations

Mr. Speaker Sir,

The Committee having held the approval hearings of the nominees regarding their suitability, observed that due process was followed in the recruitment process in line with section 45 of the CGA and section 8 of the Act.

The Committee therefore recommends that the House:

- 1. Approves the nomination of Miss. Lynn Kitwan for appointment as the County Chief Officer, Department of Public Health and Sanitation, by H.E. the Governor, Kitui County.**



2. Approves the nomination of Dr. Musyoka Benson Wambua for appointment as the County Chief Officer, Department of Medical Services by H.E. the Governor, Kitui County. The nominee should only be appointed upon his resignation/transfer of service from the current public office held in the County Government of Turkana.
3. Approves the nomination of Mr. Aggrey Kinyalili Kamba for appointment as the County Chief Officer, Department of Drugs and Medical Supplies by H.E. the Governor, Kitui County.

CHAPTER ONE

1.0 PREFACE

1.1 Establishment and Mandate of the Committee.

Mr. Speaker Sir,

1. The Committee on Health and Sanitation is established under Standing Order 190(5) and is mandated to:
 - i. Investigate, inquire into and report on all matters relating to the mandate, management, activities, administration, operation and estimates of the assigned department;
 - ii. Study programs and policy objectives of departments and the effectiveness of the implementation;
 - iii. Study and review all county legislation referred to it;
 - iv. Study, assess and analyse the relative success of departments as measured by the results obtained as compared with their stated objectives;
 - v. Investigate and inquire into all matters relating to the assigned departments as they may deem necessary, and as may be referred to them by the County Assembly;
 - vi. To vet and report on all appointments where the constitution or any law requires the County Assembly to approve, except those under Standing Order 185(Committee on Appointments); and
 - vii. Make reports and recommendations to the County Assembly as often as possible, including recommendation of proposed legislation.

1.2 Subjects under the Committee

2. In accordance with the Second Schedule of the Standing Orders, the Committee is mandated to consider health and sanitation matters.
3. In executing its mandate, the Committee oversees the Ministry of Health and Sanitation.

CHAPTER 2

2.0 BACKGROUND

2.1 Legal Framework

Qualifications for appointment as a Chief Officer.

Mr. Speaker Sir,

5. The Office of the Chief Officer is established under section 45 of the County Governments Act (CGA) which states that:

(1) The governor shall—

(a) nominate qualified and experienced county chief officers from among persons competitively sourced and recommended by the County Public Service Board; and

(b) with the approval of the County Assembly, appoint county chief officers.

(2) The office of a county chief officer shall be an office in the county public service.

(3) A county chief officer shall be responsible to the respective county executive committee member for the administration of a county department as provided under section 46.

(4) The county chief officer shall be the authorized officer in respect of exercise of delegated power.

6. Through an advertisement dated 7th October, 2022 (annexure 2), the Kitui County Public Service Board called for applications from qualified persons outlining the requirements for appointment, including the following:

- i. Be a holder of at least a first Degree from a University recognized in Kenya;
- ii. Have relevant knowledge and experience of more than 5 years in the relevant field;
- iii. Satisfy the requirements of Chapter Six of the Constitution on leadership and integrity;
- iv. Be conversant with the Constitution and all devolution related legislations.

Mr. Speaker Sir,

Article 73(2) of the Constitution was paramount to the Committee as it executed its mandate. It states that the guiding principles of leadership and integrity include:

- a) Selection on the basis of personal integrity, competence and suitability;
 - b) Objectivity and impartiality in decision making, and in ensuring that decisions are not influenced by nepotism, favoritism, other improper motives or corruption practices;
 - c) Selfless service based solely on public interest, demonstrated by:
 - i) Honesty in the execution of public duties;
 - ii) The declaration of any personal interest that may conflict with public duties.
7. The nominees' suitability as to whether their abilities, experience and qualities meet the needs of the body to which the nomination is being made to were assessed after scrutiny of their academic credentials, professional training and experience, personal integrity, background and

qualities as well as their performance during the approval hearings conducted on 31st January, 2023.

2.2 Notification of the Nominations.

Mr. Speaker Sir,

8. Pursuant to section 45 of the CGA and section 6 of the Public Appointments (County Assemblies Approval) Act (PACAAA, *herein after referred to as "the Act"*), His Excellency (H.E) the Governor Dr. Julius M. Malombe notified the County Assembly of the nomination of twenty six (26) persons for appointment as County Chief Officers in various Departments through a letter 19th December, 2022 dated 4th November, 2022 referenced CGKTI/OOG/ADM/23/40 (*Annexure 3*):- The list contained the following three (3) persons nominated to serve in the County Ministry of Health and Sanitation:

1. **Miss. Lynn Kitwan**, nominee for appointment as the Chief Officer, Department of Public Health and Sanitation.
2. **Dr. Musyoka Benson Wambua**, nominee for appointment as the Chief Officer, Department of Medical Services.
3. **Mr. Aggrey Kinyalili Kamba**, nominee for appointment as the Chief Officer, Department of Drugs and Medical Supplies.

9. H.E. the Governor also forwarded the nominees' *curriculum vitae* and testimonials.

10. Further, through a letter dated 23rd December, 2022 referenced CGKTI/OOG/ADM/23/41 H.E. the Governor availed the criteria used to arrive at the nominees (*Annexure 4*).

2.3 Notification to the House and Referral to the Committee

Mr. Speaker Sir,

11. Pursuant to the provisions of section 7 of the Act and Standing Order 42, the Speaker, through a Communication dated 16th January, 2023 informed the House of the Governor's nominations upon which the names of the nominees stood committed to the Committee on Health and Sanitation for consideration.

2.4 Notification to the Public.

Mr. Speaker Sir,

12. Article 196(1)(b) of the Constitution mandates a County Assembly to facilitate public participation and involvement in the legislative business and other business of the County Assembly and its Committees. Section 7(5) of the Act requires that the public should be notified of the time and place for holding an approval hearing at least seven (7) days prior to the public hearing.
13. In compliance with the above legal provisions, on 23rd January, 2023, the Clerk of Assembly placed an advertisement in print media (*Annexure 5*) informing the public of the public hearings and further requesting them to submit written statements on oath contesting the suitability of any of the nominees. The Committee did not receive any statement(s) on oath contesting the suitability of the nominees.

2.5 Notification to the nominees.

Mr. Speaker Sir,

14. Section 7(4) of the Act requires the Clerk to notify a candidate of the time and place for holding an approval hearing by notice in two (2) newspapers

of national circulation and by writing. The Clerk of Assembly invited nominees in writing and through media, for the approval hearing, through an advertisement dated 23rd January, 2023 (*Annexure 5*).

2.6 Clearances and Compliance requirements.

Mr. Speaker Sir,

15. The County Assembly wrote to the below listed government agencies requesting them to issue reports on the nominees relating to the matters within the respective agencies' mandate: -

i. Kenya Revenue Authority (KRA)

16. KRA responded through a letter dated 1st February, 2023 stating that all nominees' itax compliance certificates were valid (*Annexure 6*).

ii. Higher Educations Loans Board (HELB).

17. The nominees were cleared by HELB through a letter dated 24th January, 2023 (*Annexure 7*).

iii. Office of the Official Receiver.

18. The Official Receiver through a letter dated 24th January, 2023 (*Annexure 8*) confirmed that none of the nominees had been subject to any insolvency proceedings.

iv. Office of the Registrar of Political Parties (ORPP)

19. The Registrar of Political Parties through a letter dated 23rd January, 2023 (*Annexure 9*) confirmed that none of the nominees were officials of any registered political party.

v. Universities- Authentication of Nominees' academic certificates

20. All the concerned Universities confirmed that the degree certificates held by all the nominees were authentic (*Annexure 10-12*).

vi. Kenya National Examination Council (KNEC)

21. The Council confirmed that Certificates of Secondary School Education held by all the nominees were authentic (*Annexure 13-15*).

vii. Credit Reference Bureau (CRB).

22. Metropol CRB Ltd and TransUnion CRB Ltd confirmed that the Credit Reference Certificates submitted by the nominees to the County Assembly were valid and authentic (*Annexure 16-17*).

viii. Independent Electoral and Boundaries Commission (IEBC)

23. The independent Electoral and Boundaries Commission through a letter dated 23rd January, 2023, verified the voter status of the nominees. (*Annexure 18*)

2.7 Report of the County Public Service Board on the Nominations

Mr. Speaker Sir,

24. Pursuant to the provisions of section 45 of the CGA, the County Public Service Board invited applications from suitably qualified persons for the positions of County Chief Officers, via an advertisement in the Dailies dated 7th October, 2022 (*Annexure 2*) with the closing date being 14th October, 2022.

25. A total of 1,866 applications were submitted for consideration. 208 candidates were shortlisted for the 26 positions with 8 persons shortlisted per position. Interviews were conducted from 23rd November, 2022 to 9th December, 2022. Thereafter, the Board submitted the names of candidates as ranked for each post to the Office of the Governor for nomination of suitable and qualified candidates.

2.7 Committee proceedings

Mr. Speaker Sir,

26. The Committee having received the names of the nominees was obligated to conduct approval hearings and make determination of the nominee's suitability or otherwise within 21 sitting days from the 1st sitting date as provided for in section 9 of the Act.
27. The Committee held its first meeting to consider this subject matter on 16th January 2023, and considered its rules of procedure during the exercise and agreed on a framework for the approval hearing, as guided by the applicable laws. It held four (4) sittings within which it examined and reviewed the nominees' certificates and testimonials.
28. The committee held two sittings on 31st January, 2023 in order to conduct its approval hearings for the nominees.
29. Thereafter, the Committee retreated to prepare its report as from 1st - 4th February 2023. The report of the Committee contains its recommendations based on the outcome of the vetting and approval hearings of the nominees.

CHAPTER 3

3.0 APPROVAL HEARINGS OF THE NOMINEES

Mr. Speaker Sir,

30. The Committee held two (2) sittings on 31st January, 2023 during which it conducted approval hearings and examined the nominees against the criteria set out under section 8 of the Act as follows:

- a) the procedure used to arrive at the nominee including the criteria for the shortlisting of the nominees;
- b) any constitutional or statutory requirements relating to the office in question; and
- c) the suitability of the nominee for the appointment proposed having regard to whether the nominee's credentials, abilities, experience and qualities meet the needs of the body to which the nomination is being made.

Guided by the above legal provision, the Committee interrogated the following issues to ascertain the nominees' suitability, amongst others:

- i. Academic qualifications
- ii. Employment record and work experience
- iii. Professional associations
- iv. Public office, political activities and affiliations
- v. Suitability for the position
- vi. Tax compliance
- vii. Integrity
- viii. Understanding of the department nominated to

3.1 MISS. LYNN KITWAN

Mr. Speaker Sir,

31. Miss. Lynn Kitwan, the nominee for the Department of Public Health and Sanitation appeared before the Committee on 31st January, 2023 at 9:00 a.m. and was vetted under oath.

The Committee noted the following: -

Date and place of birth

32. The nominee is a female Kenyan citizen born in 1992 and comes from Endau Malalani ward, Kitui East Sub County.

Academic and professional qualifications

33. She holds a Bachelor of Science in Medical Laboratory Sciences from Technical University of Kenya awarded in 2015.

She is also pursuing a Masters of Science in Infectious Diseases and Vaccinology at Jomo Kenyatta University of Agriculture and Technology and has attended several short courses and trainings.

Work experience

34. She has over six years work experience and currently works as a Senior Scientific Officer at Metropolis Star Laboratory whereby her duties include testing specimen, documenting results, helping in medical issues diagnostics, ensuring compliance with waste disposal procedures for biological and hazardous waste, amongst other duties. She is also a part time lecturer at Thika School of Medical and Health Sciences where she oversees proposal and thesis writing, lecturing, fostering community outreach programs in training on infectious diseases, exam preparation and evaluation.

35. She has also worked as a laboratory technologist/ health safety officer at Lancet Kenya whereby she assisted in supervision, oversaw implementation of health and safety policies, and trained interns and students. In addition, she worked as an intern at Lancet Kenya.

Income and net worth

36. She estimated her net worth to be Kenya Shillings Ten Million and Three Hundred Thousand (Kshs. 10.3 million).

Integrity

37. The nominee submitted that she had never been charged in any court of law or adversely mentioned in any investigatory or parliamentary report of inquiry.

Original Documents

38. During the approval hearing, the nominee submitted the following original documents to the Committee for confirmation.

- i. Identification Card.
- ii. Academic and professional certificates.
- iii. Clearances from: - KRA, HELB, and CRB.

She also submitted certified copies of academic and professional certificates.

3.1.1 SECTOR SPECIFIC QUESTIONS TO THE NOMINEE

Mr. Speaker Sir,

39. The Committee posed several sector specific questions to the nominee to which she responded as follows: -

On waste management and general sanitation

40. The nominee submitted that she will put up waste disposal pits around towns, initiate recycling systems in order to prevent waste of potentially

useful materials, conduct clean up exercises after every market day and ensure there are officers on the ground collecting first-hand information on the problems at hand.

On the issue of high employee turnover and retention of specialized staff

41. The nominee committed to motivate members of staff in her department by investing in their professional development through continuous trainings, prioritizing work-life balance, promotions and creating an open-door policy so as to encourage continuous feedback on performance.

On corruption during issuance of licenses

42. The nominee mentioned that she will work in partnership with the County Executive committee member in her ministry so as to formulate regulations guiding the issuance of licenses in order to issue licenses to only those who meet the set requirements.

43. Further, the nominee undertook to digitalize payment systems so as to eliminate room for errors and omissions or bribery temptations.

On promotion of preventive healthcare

44. The nominee acknowledges the importance of preventive healthcare in the detection and prevention of medical problems before they can become major. She undertook to promote preventive healthcare through sensitization of the public on nutrition and hygiene issues. She also aims to enhance community participation on such issues.

45. In addition, she intends to partner with Non-Governmental Organizations (N.G.Os) for funding support to cater for deployment of more public health officers to the grassroots.

3.2 DR. MUSYOKA BENSON WAMBUA

Mr. Speaker Sir,

46. Dr. Musyoka Benson Wambua, the Chief Officer nominee for the Department of Medical Services appeared before the Committee on 31st January, 2023 at 10:00 AM and was vetted under oath.

The Committee noted the following:

Date and place of birth.

47. The nominee is a male Kenyan citizen born in 1990 and comes from Nzambani Ward, in Kitui East Sub County.

Academic and professional qualifications.

48. The nominee holds a Bachelor of Pharmacy from the University of Nairobi. He is pursuing a Masters in Health Systems Management at Kenya Methodist University. He has also attended some short courses and trainings.

Work experience

49. The nominee has over seven (7) years work experience and is currently working as the Sub County Pharmacist, Turkana South, County Government of Turkana. His duties include quantification, forecasting and supply of health products and technologies for all health facilities in the Sub County, preparing pharmacy budgets, workplans and making policies guiding distribution and medicine use in health facilities, planning and conducting training programs for pharmacy staff, monitoring medication safety and reporting on arising issues, acting as the County pharmacist, amongst other duties. He has also worked as the Sub County Pharmacist in Turkana West.

In addition, he worked as a hospital pharmacist at Lodwar County and Referral Hospital in the County Government of Turkana whereby he prepared, dispensed and provided medication to patients, educated and counseled patients in medication related issues, oversaw distribution, storage and management of medicine, amongst other duties. He was also a pharmacist intern in Machakos at the Ministry of Health, National Government, whereby he did industrial rotation at Cosmos Pharmaceuticals Ltd, hospital rotation at Machakos Level 5 Hospital and community pharmacy rotation at Masaku Chemist Ltd.

Income and net worth

50. The nominee indicated that his estimated net worth is Kenya Shillings Thirty Seven Million and Seven Hundred Thousand (Kshs. 37.7 million).

Integrity

51. The nominee submitted that he had never been charged in any court of law or adversely mentioned in any investigatory or parliamentary report of inquiry.

Public officer

52. The nominee is a public officer as he currently works as a Sub County Pharmacist, Turkana West, County Government of Turkana.

Original Documents

53. During the approval hearing, the nominee submitted the following original document to the Committee for confirmation.

- i. Identification Card.
- ii. Academic and professional certificates.
- iii. Clearances from:- KRA, HELB and CRB.

He also submitted certified copies of academic and professional certificates.

3.2.1 SECTOR SPECIFIC QUESTIONS TO THE NOMINEE.

Mr. Speaker Sir,

The Committee posed the following sector specific questions to the nominee to which he responded as follows:-

On corruption in the health services sector

54. The nominee understands that eliminating corruption in the health sector is imperative to strengthening health systems in our county. In order to do so, the nominee intends to create awareness among the people in order to educate them about their rights and obligations. This will also encourage the public to speak up and expose corrupt activities.

55. In addition, he intends to install Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) cameras, suggestion boxes and toll-free numbers where the members of the public can anonymously raise complaints.

On retention of specialized medics and reduction of turnover

56. The nominee intends to reduce employee turnover rate by motivating members of staff through promotions, revival of the staff medical cover, employment of adequate staff in order to prevent employee burnout as a result of overworking.

On being a member of the wiper democratic movement

57. The nominee stated that he is currently a member of the political party. He is aware that his position expects him to be impartial and politically neutral in the discharge of his duties and for that reason, he intends to shelve his political ambitions in order to dedicate his time to serving the people.

Unnecessary referral of patients to private facilities

58. The nominee stated that the radiology and pharmacy departments were notorious for these unnecessary referrals. He therefore undertook to ensure that pharmacies are always fully stocked and the radiology machines regularly serviced and maintained in order to keep them operational.
59. In addition, the clinician and the pharmacy department need to work together to ensure that only available drugs are prescribed and that the pharmacy maintains buffer stocks for the fast-moving medicines.
60. The nominee intends to get weekly reports indicating the number of patients being referred to private facilities and the reasons for the referrals.

On strengthening of ambulance services

61. The nominee stated that the county currently has a draft ambulance policy whose formulation he intends to fast-track. The county currently has 46 ambulances out of which only 22 are operational. He therefore aims to operationalize all of them and assign two drivers to each ambulance so as to ensure they run for 24 hours. He anticipates that each ward will have at least one operational ambulance.

On management of casuals and community health volunteers

62. The nominee stated that there is a huge shortage of nurses in our facilities and therefore he intends to absorb some of those on part time basis and employ them on permanent terms. He also intends to ensure timely payment of the casuals and their absorption into permanent and pensionable terms.

63. He intends to engage the community health volunteers and reinstate their monthly stipend.

On issue of chronic absenteeism of medical personnel from their work stations

64. The nominee agreed that absenteeism of doctors and other medical personnel from their work place could lead to delays in administering emergency services. This contributes greatly to deaths which otherwise would have been avoided had the doctors been within their work stations.

65. To address this issue, the nominee intends to be hands-on and establish a good working environment for his staff. He also proposes to introduce a duty roster/rota which will guide smooth operation of the facilities. The duty roster/rota will assist in management of personnel by reducing work overload, preventing interruption of services and promoting quality services.

66. This will also assist the management keep a record of shift attendance and also keep track of those responsible for each shift in case of anything.

3.3 MR. AGGREY KINYALILI KAMBA

Mr. Speaker Sir,

67. Mr. Aggrey Kinyalili Kamba, the nominee for the Department of Drugs and Medical Supplies appeared before the Committee on 31st January, 2023 at 2.30 p.m. and was vetted under oath.

The Committee noted the following:

Date and place of birth

68. The nominee is a male Kenyan citizen born in 1974 and comes from Kisasi Ward, Kitui Rural Sub County.

Academic and professional qualifications

69. The nominee holds a Bachelor of Science in Biochemistry from Egerton University and a Masters in Business Administration (MBA) from the University of Nairobi. He has also attended short courses and holds several certificates.

Work experience

70. The nominee has over twenty years work experience and currently works as the General Manager, Business Development at Autosterile East Africa Limited. His duties include overseeing daily commercial activities, training staff, creating and managing budgets, evaluating performance and productivity and reporting to the Board of Directors, amongst other duties.
71. He has also worked in the same company as Business Development Manager whereby he managed the commercial aspects of the business identified and registered new products, closed new business deals, etc. Previously, he worked in the same company as a Sales and Marketing Manager with his duties being restructuring the sales and marketing department, achieving set sale targets, developing and executing sales and marketing plans, recruiting and training sales teams, etc.
72. He has also worked at Universal Corporation Limited as a Sales Manager, at Norbrook Kenya Limited as a Marketing Manager, at Omaera Pharmaceuticals Limited as the Country Manager, at Cadila Pharmaceuticals E.A. Limited as a Medical representative and at Glaxowellcome K. Ltd as a quality control officer.

Income and net worth

73. He estimated his net worth to be Kenya Shillings Fifty-Six Million Six Hundred and Ten Thousand (Kshs. 56,610,000/=).

Integrity

74. The nominee submitted that he has never been charged in any court of law or adversely mentioned in any investigatory or parliamentary report of inquiry.

Original Documents

75. During the approval hearing, the nominee submitted the following original document to the Committee for confirmation.

- i. Identification Card.
- ii. Academic and professional certificates.
- iii. Clearances from:- KRA, HELB and CRB.

He also submitted certified copies of academic and professional certificates as required by the advertisement.

3.3.1 SECTOR SPECIFIC QUESTIONS TO THE NOMINEE

Mr. Speaker Sir,

76. The Committee posed several sector specific questions to the nominee to which he responded as follows:-

On relating his Education and Experience to the Position;

77. The nominee said that his education background in Biochemistry had given him the pre-requisite skills to execute his duties. He said that he had 21 years wealth of experience. He had recently been engaged in a committee that was involved in the development of the current list of essential drugs which gave him a hands-on experience in the area.

78. He said he had a good relationship with Kenya Medical Supplies Authority (KEMSA) having worked with them for some time. This relationship would

come in handy in his docket. He also mentioned that he had experience in the drugs regulatory framework

On his relationship with the Assembly Committee on Health and Sanitation;

79. He said that he recognizes the role of the Committee in coming up with health bills and overseeing his duties as a Chief Officer. He further confirmed that he would work hand in hand with the Assembly Committee on Health and Sanitation if approved and appointed to the position.

On the challenges and solutions to the problem of shortage of drugs;

80. The nominee stated that lack of proper budgeting had contributed greatly to the perennial shortage of drugs and therefore it was important to research effectively on the sufficient financial estimates required for the purchase of the drugs. He also mentioned that it was crucial for the department to purchase the right quantification of drugs based on the facilities needs.

81. Distinguishing the budget lines for various hospital requirements for both pharmaceuticals and non-pharmaceuticals would also ensure none of the two is disadvantaged in procuring them.

On how to track supplies inventory to safeguard stocks

82. The nominee underscored the need for proper procurement systems and efficient supply chain management to ensure proper stock controls.

83. He pointed out on the need to strengthen and work closely with Health product and technologies unit committee which receives the health products and distributes them to the facilities.

84. He further advocated on the use of integrated digitalization in drug management i.e. Health Management Systems which can be very effective in managing the supplies.

On how to deal with theft of drugs in Health Facilities

85. He said that he would invoke the Employment Act in dealing with the crooked employees in his department.

CHAPTER 4

89. She has over six (6) years work experience and currently works as a Senior Scientific Officer at Metropolis Star Laboratory and as a part time lecturer at Thika School of Medical and Health Sciences. She has also worked as a laboratory technologist/ health at Lancet Kenya and interned in the same institution. Her academic credentials, professional training and experience comply with section 8 of the Act.
90. She was recommended for appointment by the County Public Service Board in compliance with section 45(1)(a) of the CGA.
91. The nominee meets the requirements of Chapter 6 of the Constitution on leadership and integrity having been cleared by the relevant government agencies.
92. The nominee demonstrated knowledge of topical, administrative and technical issues touching on the County Governments and has the requisite abilities, qualifications and experience to serve as a Chief Officer in the County department to which she has been nominated to.

4.2 COMMITTEE OBSERVATIONS ON THE SUITABILITY OF DR. MUSYOKA BENSON WAMBUA



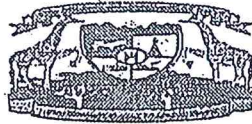

RE: NOMINATION OF PERSONS TO BE APPOINTED AS CHIEF OFFICERS

Following the advertisements for the positions of chief officers (CO's) by the Kitui County Public Service Board (CPSB) in the print media and website on 7th October, 2022 and 14th October, 2022 a total of 1,866 applications were received. A total of 208 applicants were shortlisted for the 26 posts with eight (8) persons shortlisted per position. Interviews were conducted from Wednesday November 23rd, 2022 to Friday December 9th, 2022.

After the conclusion of the interviews, the County Public Service Board submitted the names of the candidates as ranked for each post to the Office of the Governor on Tuesday December 13, 2022 to facilitate consideration for appointment of suitable and qualified candidates.

Please note four (4) current chief officers (COs) who were appointed in 2017/2018 by my predecessor H.E. Charity Kaluki Ngilu moved to court on 13th December 2022 alleging their appointments were on permanent and pensionable (P&P) basis and not contractual, among other prayers. The officers were granted conservatory orders by the Employment and Labour Relations Court (ELRC) thus restraining the Governor from appointing new chief officers to the four departments listed below or replacing them as COs until the case is heard and determined. The ex-parte orders were served to the Governors Office on Wednesday December 14, 2022.

The initial court order was extended by the ELRC during an Interparties appearance on Monday December 19, 2022. I am advised the ELRC orders were also served to the County Assembly and I trust they have been availed to you. It is noteworthy the ELRC Court did not injunct the entire recruitment process as prayed by the four applicants/plaintiffs.

The four officers and their departments are:-

1. Godfrey Zakayo Kimanzi – Chief Officer, Office of the Governor. *(There is however another current Chief Officer in the Office of the Governor responsible for Public Service Management & Administration).*
2. Geoffrey M. Changangu – Chief Officer, Department of ICT & Youth Development.
3. Enoch Ngũthu – Chief Officer, Department of Livestock, Apiculture & Fisheries Development
4. Eng. Joseph Kimanga – Chief Officer, Department of Gender, Sports & Culture

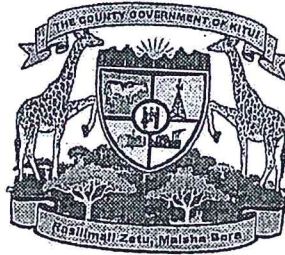

It is impereative noting that an assembly resolution to the new changes is also necessary among other documents that are deemed important for this exercise.

RE: NOMINATION FOR APPOINTMENT OF COUNTY CHIEF OFFICERS

Your letter Ref: CAK/ADM/15/7/(44) dated 21st December, 2022 on the above refers.
We wish to respond to the issues raised as follows:-

1. Rationale for the Post 2022 General Election Departmental Structure

The County Governor is obligated by law to ensure the structuring of the County Government after a General Election in a manner that will most effectively and efficiently deliver on the incoming government's vision and development agenda. This is the letter and spirit of section 30(2) (e) of the County Government Act, 2012.

The **twenty six (26)** departments under the reorganised county government structure were presented to the pre-election County Executive Committee and formed the basis of the Supplementary Budget I that the said County Executive Committee approved on **Wednesday October 19, 2022** and thus complying with the requirements of Section 46 of the County Governments Act, 2012.

It is noteworthy, the said Supplementary Budget I was subsequently forwarded to the County Assembly and was accordingly approved on **Wednesday November 30, 2022**. The **twelve (12)** ministries and **twenty six (26)** departments were part of the Governor's inaugural speech at the opening of the 3rd County Assembly delivered on the

11th October, 2022. Hence, the County Assembly was duly indulged on the matter, as necessary.

The Kitui County Public Service Board equally adopted and maintained the departments and proceeded to prepare advertisements for potential applicants to fill the subject chief officer positions in the **twenty six (26)** departments on the **7th and 14th October, 2022.**

2. Procedure used to arrive at the nominees including criteria for shortlisting

Following the advertisements for the positions of Chief Officers (CO's) by the Kitui County Public Service Board (CPSB) in the print media and website on **7th October, 2022** and **14th October, 2022** a total of **1,866** applications were received.

The County Public Service Board (CPSB) has advised my office that they were guided by the Constitutional Values and Principles in Article 10 and 232 of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010, and they used the following criteria to shortlist a total of 208 applicants for the **26** posts with **eight (8)** persons shortlisted per position:

- i. At least one candidate from each of the **Eight(8)** Sub Counties per position where applicable
- ii. At least one candidate from each of the **forty (40)** wards in all the positions where applicable
- iii. Meets the minimum qualifications and experience as per the advert
- iv. Representation of special groups such as Persons Living with Disability (PLWD), Women and Youth
- v. Regional balancing/ County diversity
- vi. Minorities

The County Public Service Board conducted interviews from **Wednesday November 23rd, 2022** to **Friday December 9th, 2022.** After the interviews were concluded the County Public Service Board submitted the names of the candidates as ranked for each post to the Office of the Governor on **Tuesday December 13, 2022** to facilitate consideration for appointment of suitable and qualified candidates.

3. Report of the Kitui County Public Service Board on the selection of the Twenty Six (26) nominees.

The County Public Service Board's report on the scoring and ranking of the candidates shortlisted and interviewed for the **Twenty Six (26)** CO positions is herewith enclosed.



4. Criteria for Nomination for Appointment

After I was satisfied the gender, regional balance etc considerations would be realized, I opted to nominate for appointment all those candidates that were ranked highest by the County Public Service Board *granted the overriding essence of recruitment*

of CO's is effective delivery of services to our people. (See attached, my letter Ref. CGKTI/OOG/ADM/23/40 dated December 19, 2022) Besides educational qualifications and leadership management exposure/experience and potential, I have, to the extent possible, endeavored to observe the $\frac{2}{3}$ gender rule, regional balance, inter-generational and diversity inclusivity.

All the county's **eight (8)** constituencies have at least one Chief Officer (CO) nominee. **Eight (8)** of the nominees are women with **one (1)** of them coming from a marginalized/minority community in the county.

Nine (9) of the nominees are aged **37** years or below and **Seven (7)** of these are youth aged below **35** years. I was advised that none of the Persons Living with Disability (PLWD) qualified for the advertised chief officer positions.

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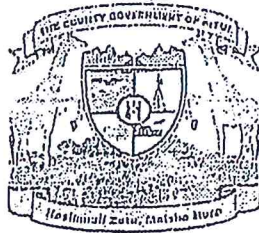

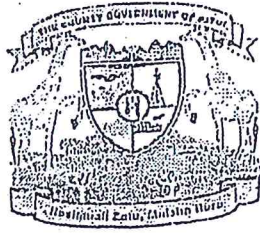

The Board deliberated on the sixteen (16) position to be advertised and made reference to the County Government Act No 17 of 2012 Section 46 (1) which states that; the county executive committee shall determine the organization of the county and its various departments, and for that purpose may—

- (a) establish, continue or vary any department, and determine the objects and purposes of the department;
- (b) determine the number and nature of departments at the decentralized units;
- (c) abolish any department; and
- (d) determine or change the name of any department.

Members deliberated further in reference to Article 46 (2) which states that; when establishing and organizing the county, the county executive committee shall take into account, and be guided by, the need to—

- (a) be responsive to the needs of the local community and the functions and competencies assigned to and transferred to the county;
- (b) facilitate a culture of public service and accountability in the county Public Service;
- (c) be performance oriented and focused on the objects of devolved government set out in Article 174 of the Constitution;
- (d) ensure that the county departments align their roles and responsibilities with the priorities and objectives set out in the county's policies and plans;
- (e) organize its departments and other structures in a flexible way in order to respond to changing priorities and circumstances;
- (f) assign clear responsibilities for the management and coordination of departments and functions;
- (g) allow participatory decision making as far as is practicable; and
- (h) provide an equitable, fair, open and non-discriminatory working environment.

The Board Concluded on this item and resolved that, the sixteen (16) departments proposed to be held by the incoming Chief Officers were not new offices in the County Public Service and did not require invoking the procedure provided for under section 62 of the County Government Act, 2012.

The Board finally resolved to advertise for the sixteen (16) positions to reach the widest coverage through the use of media and the County Website.
