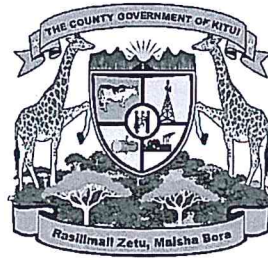

FORWARD

Mr. Speaker Sir, Section 45(1) of the County Governments Act, 2012, provides that the Governor shall nominate qualified and experienced County Chief officers from among persons competitively sourced and recommended by the County Public Service Board; and with the approval of the County Assembly, appoint county chief officers.

On 16th January, 2023 during a special sitting, pursuant to Standing Order 39 the Speaker of the County Assembly conveyed a message to the Assembly, that H.E. the Governor Dr. Julius Makau Malombe, had nominated the following:

- i. Mr. Stephen Makau Musili - Nominee to the Position of Chief Officer in the County Department of Trade, Industry, MSMEs and EIZs
- ii. Mr. Paul Ngei Monyi- Nominee to the Position of Chief Officer in the County Department of Cooperative, Citizen Groups and Economic Empowerment Initiatives

Mr. Speaker Sir, the names of the nominees were thereafter committed to the Sectoral Committee on Trade, Industry, ICT and Cooperatives.

Subsequently Assembly placed an advertisement in the Standard Newspaper dated 23rd January, 2023, inviting the nominees for vetting before the Sectoral Committee on Trade, Industry, ICT and Cooperatives, on Tuesday 31st January, 2023 from 9.00 A.M to 11.00 A.M at the Assembly Precincts and further requesting for memorandums for or against the nominees on or before Friday, 27th January, 2023.

However, by the set deadline of 27th January, 2023, no memoranda were received from the public on the two nominees' nomination.

The two, appeared before the Committee on 31st January, 2023 for the approval hearings at the Kitui Assembly precincts.

Mr. Speaker Sir, the Committee considered the nomination of the following nominees in line with **Section 8 of the Public Appointments (County Assemblies Approval) Act, 2017** and prepared its report: *stop → and these were its report*

- i. Mr. Stephen Makau Musili - Nominee to the Position of Chief Officer in the County Department of Trade, Industry, MSMEs and EIZs
- ii. Mr. Paul Ngei Monyi- Nominee to the Position of Chief Officer in the County Department of Cooperative, Citizen Groups and Economic Empowerment Initiatives

In its report, the Committee has made the following observations: - **THAT;**

1. **Mr. Stephen Makau Musili** , the Chief Officer Nominee to the Department of Trade, Industry, MSMEs is academically and professionally qualified for the position.
 - He has all the required clearances as per chapter 6 of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010.
 - The nominee demonstrated knowledge of topical, administrative and technical issues touching on the County department.
 - The nominee has the requisite abilities, qualifications and experience to serve as a Chief Officer in the county department Trade
 - The nominee clearly exhibited an understanding of the roles of a Chief Officer.
 - **Mr. Paul Ngei Monyi**, the Chief Officer Nominee to the Department of Cooperative, Citizen Groups and Economic Empowerment Initiatives is academically and professionally qualified for the position.
 - He has met all the required clearances as per chapter 6 of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010.
 - The nominee demonstrated knowledge and experience in Cooperatives, Citizen Groups and Economic Empowerment.

- That the nominee clearly exhibited an understanding of the roles of a chief officer.

Mr. Speaker Sir, having considered the suitability of the nominees and pursuant to Section 8 of the Public Appointments (County Assemblies Approval) Act, 2017, the Committee recommends the **approval** of nominees by the Assembly and Subsequent appointment by H.E. the Governor Dr. Julius Makau Malombe as follows:

- i. Mr. Stephen Makau Musili - Nominee to the Position of Chief Officer in the County Department of Trade, Industry, MSMEs and EIZs.
- ii. Mr. Paul Ngei Monyi- Nominee to the Position of Chief Officer in the County Department of Cooperative, Citizen Groups and Economic Empowerment Initiatives

This committee is one of the Sectoral Committees established under the Standing Orders 190(1), among its functions are to vet and report on all appointments where the constitution or any law requires the County Assembly to approve, except those under Standing Order 185 (Committee on Appointments)

- iv. Study, assess and analyse the relative success of departments as measured by the results obtained as compared with their stated objectives;
- v. Investigate and inquire into all matters relating to the assigned departments as they may deem necessary, and as may be referred to them by the County Assembly;
- vi. To vet and report on all appointments where the Constitution or any law requires the County Assembly to approve, except those under Standing Order 185 (Committee Appointments); and**
- vii. Make reports and recommendations to the county assembly as often as possible, including recommendation of proposed legislation.

In accordance with the Second Schedule of the Standing Orders, the Committee is mandated to consider matters of trade development,

regulations, including market, trade licenses (excluding regulation of professions), fair trading practices and cooperative societies etc.



CHAPTER TWO

2.0 BACKGROUND

2.1 Nominations and Notification to the Speaker

Mr. Speaker Sir,

On 19th December, 2022 and pursuant to Section 6 of the Public Appointments (County Assemblies) Approval Act, 2017 H.E. The Governor of Kitui forwarded to the Speaker the names of the nominees to the positions of: -

1. Mr. Stephen Makau Musili- Chief Officer Department of Trade, Industry, MSMSEs and County EIZs;
2. Mr. Paul Ngei Monyi- Chief Officer Department of Cooperatives, Citizen Groups and Economic Empowerment Initiative (**See Annexure 1**)

2.2 Speakers Committal

The Speaker in his Communication from the Chair, issued on **Monday, 16th January, 2023** and pursuant to Section 14(3) of the County Government Act, and Section 7(1) of the Public Appointments (County Assemblies) Approval Act, 2017, committed the names of the nominees to the sectoral Committee on Trade, Industry, ICT and Cooperatives for approval hearing pursuant to section 7 of the Public Appointments (County Assemblies) Approval Act, 2017, and subsequently table a report to the House within twenty one (21) days.

2.3 Notification of the nominees and the public

Mr. Speaker Sir,

Pursuant to Article 196 (1) (a) (b) and (2) of the Constitution and Section 7(4) and (5) of the Public Appointments (County Assemblies) Approval Act, 2017, an advertisement was placed in the Standard News Paper on **23rd January, 2023** inviting the nominees to appear before the Committee on Trade, Industry, ICT and Cooperatives on **31st January, 2023** in Tent 1.

Further, members of the public were expected to participate in the vetting process by submission of written statements on oath on the suitability or otherwise of the nominees by **27th January, 2023**. (See Annexure 3)

As at the close of business on **27th January, 2023** no memoranda had been submitted.

2.4 Report of the CPSB on the Nomination Procedure and Criteria

The Committee reviewed the procedure and criteria used to derive at the nominees as submitted by H.E. The Governor vide a letter dated **23rd December, 2022**, which was satisfactory as it was comprehensive on how the nominee were derived at pursuant to section 45(1) (a) of the County Government Act, 2012 which states that,

“The Governor shall nominate qualified and experienced county chief officers from among persons competitively sourced and recommended by the County Public Service Board.” (See Annexure 2)

CHAPTER THREE

3.0 APPROVAL HEARINGS

Mr. Speaker Sir,

The Committee, in the course of discharge of its mandate, conducted an approval hearing on 31st January, 2023 for the nominees for appointment to the positions of: -

1. Chief Officer Department of Trade, Industry, MSMSEs and County EIZs
2. Chief Officer Department of Cooperatives, Citizen Groups and Economic Empowerment Initiative

The Committee held two sittings during which the nominees appeared before the Committee and were vetted in accordance with the law.

In conducting the vetting process, the Committee examined the nominees against the following criteria, amongst others, in accordance with the Public Appointments (County Assemblies) Approval Act and Article 73(2) (a) (b) (c) (d) and (e) of the Constitution and other applicable laws:

- i) Academic qualifications;
- ii) Employment records;
- iii) professional affiliations;
- iv) potential conflict of interest;
- v) knowledge of the relevant subject matter;
- vi) overall suitability for the position;
- vii) tax compliance;
- viii) Integrity;
- x) Expectation and key priority areas.

3.1 Mr. Stephen Makau Musili

Mr. Speaker Sir,



The nominee made his presentation under oath after which he took Members through the vetting questionnaire as members thoroughly scrutinized his testimonials.

The nominee while defending his case and answering the Committee members questions stated that he would;

- i. Steer policy implementation on matters pertaining the said portfolio;
- ii. Advise H.E The Governor on matters pertinent to trade portfolio;
- iii. Maintain strategic direction to the department.

3.1.1 Sector Specific Questions to the Nominee.

The Committee posed the following sector specific questions to the nominee to which he responded as follows: -

3.1.1.1 link up of farm produce with both local, national and international markets.

The nominee highlighted that farming is one of the key activities of the county for livelihood and for the farmers to be motivated, he committed himself to work and cooperate with other ministries so as to undertake the following; -

- i. create a serious plat form for marketing farm produce;
- ii. organize for investor conference and trade show;
- iii. Facilitate proper and modern storage of farm produce;
- iv. Encourage private public partnership in farming;
- v. Encourage farmers to work closely with expertise persons.

3.1.1.2 Promotion of Small and Medium Enterprises

The nominee informed the committee that he would undertake the following to ensure the presence of small and medium enterprises is felt in the county;

- i. Training them to ensure they are well equipped with the relevant skills of trading and running business;
- ii. Build a modern market in Mwingi and Mutomo;
- iii. Provide infrastructural facilities that shall ensure smooth operation of business;
- iv. Shall ensure that modern facilities for smooth running of their business are available especially hair dresser, barbers, cobblers etc.

3.1.1.3 Value addition on sand harvesting in Kitui County

The nominee informed the committee that he was the chairperson of this committee during his tenure as a Member of County Assembly in Second Assembly. Sand harvesting was a critical concern for this county and extreme. However, value for money could not be realized through revenue collection in the county.

For the value for money to be realized from sand harvesting and ensure there is efficient collection of revenue from such, the nominee had the following to the committee;

- i. Benchmark with Makueni Sand Authority and any other county which are efficiently working and apply the same in Kitui in order to control sand harvesting;
- ii. Gazette all the areas where sand harvesting is done to ensure there is control of sand harvesting.

3.1.1.4 Understanding of EIZs

The nominee informed members on the broad meaning of EIZs as Economic Investment Zones and mentioned as follow;

- a) Tseikuru/Mumoni/Kyuso economic zone;
- b) Mwingi town and its environs economic zone;

- c) Mui basin economic zone;
- d) Kitui town and its environs economic zone;
- e) Kanyangi, Kwa –Vonza/Kanyonyoo economic zone.
- f) Kanziko/Mutha/Mutomo economic zone.

The nominee further reiterated that these zones need the support of his docket as they are economically potential for value addition for both the people and the county and for this to be realized, he would undertake the following;

- i. promote infrastructural expansion and development in these zones so as to ease movement of goods.
- ii. Invite investors in all the regions that minerals have been discovered for extraction so as to empower the people living standards by providing employment and growth of the economy e.g. coal in Mui basin, lime stone in Kanziko and Kyuso.
- iii. Spearhead operationalization and charter of Mwingi municipality so as to invite donors and investors in the region.

3.1.1.5 Management of KICOTEC, KIYOSEC and Stone Crusher

The nominee responded to the committee that KICOTEC and stone Crusher are government corporates which are managed by a board pursuant to the Kitui County Corporate Act.

He informed members that him being the chairperson of this committee in the Second Assembly is aware of the mismanagement of those corporations as they tried to salvage the situation through their oversight role however the predecessor government was not cooperative.

In order to ensure that this does not recur, the nominee promised to work closely with the Assembly to ensure proper use and management of government assets and bodies.

He further cited that he will organize;

- i. an audit of KICOTEC to establish the number of workforce and downsize it to a reasonable to ensure that it generates revenue to the County;
- ii. revival of KICOTEC to ensure it generates revenue to the County Government and also create employment for the youth;
- iii. dismantle the cartels in KICOTEC by purchasing raw materials straight from the manufacturer because those cartels used to supply law materials at very high prices hence making KICOTEC products very expensive to buy both locally and nationally and;
- iv. ensure that genuine suppliers are paid to ensure smooth running of KICOTEC.

3.1.2 Discrepancy in the order of names

While cross checking the nominee's national identity card and academic credentials the following discrepancy was noted;

The nominee acknowledged the discrepancy in his names and stated he has sworn in an affidavit on the same dated **12th May, 2022** curing the aforesaid anomaly.
(See Annexure 13)

3.2 Mr. Paul Ngei Monyi

The nominee made his presentation under oath after which he took Members through the vetting questionnaire as members thoroughly scrutinized his testimonials.

3.2.1 Sector Specific Questions to the Nominee.

The Committee posed the following sector specific questions to the nominee to which he responded as follows: -

3.2.1.1 The vision for the line he is seeking appointment and key priorities he will undertake

The nominee stated that there are around 356 cooperatives in Kitui county with membership totaling 82,400. Out of those cooperatives 25% of them are dormant, 20% are active. To empower and activate them the nominee cited to undertake the following;

- i. revive dormant cooperatives by changing the system of governance, helping them come up with comprehensive Constitution and emphasized the need to elect new blood to manage them.
- ii. Do a surveillance to ascertain what causes dormancy in these cooperatives and whether members wish to regroup among themselves.
- iii. work with the technical team in his department to ensure that there is compliance among the cooperatives in their by-laws.
- iv. introduce capacity building programs to cooperatives so as to ensure they are trained on entrepreneurship, financial management and record keeping.

- v. work tirelessly to ensure there is efficiency in line with cooperative objectives and support them in product branding e.g packaging and marketing.

3.2.1.2 Pending bills

While responding to the question on pending bills the nominee noted that the county has an accumulative pending bill of approximately 2.4B. However, he stated that H.E The Governor has formed a committee to look into the matter and shall commit himself to pay according to what will be recommended and approved by the committee and seconded by the governor.

In order to ensure that the issue of pending bills does not recur, the nominee promised to undertake the following;

- i. Spend within the approved County budget specifically for that financial year;
- ii. to follow the procurement process to later so as to do away with incompetent suppliers and contractors;
- iii. verify projects before the payment is done to avoid payment of incomplete or stalled projects;
- iv. promptness and timely payment of the contractors and suppliers;
- v. conduct an internal audit to verify payment documents before approval of payment on any project is done by the department.

3.2.1.3 Unstable cooperatives in the county and measures to take.

The nominee while responding to the question noted that there are approximately 360 cooperatives across the county.

Commenting on the same, he said that being experienced and working with groups, he realized that the main cause of dormancy of cooperatives is weak and unstable governance which is caused by the elderly people in the management and ignorant members, therefore he would device the following measures: -

- i Facilitate registration of cooperatives per sector (honey producers, tailoring and garment making, charcoal producers etc.);
- ii Support for and revival of dormant cooperatives through partnerships and capacity building in management, access to finance, production and marketing.
- iii Pre-training and strengthening of cooperative societies through enforcing self-regulations in the internal operations.

3.2.1.4 Facilitation of registration of cooperatives

The nominee stated that before undertaking the facilitation of the cooperatives, he would: -

- i. carry out the identification of both active and dormant cooperatives for example Kamaki, Yatta B2 ranch, Sosoma, Mwingi sand Harvesters among others;
- ii. educate members of co-operatives so as to learn on how to actively participate in the management of their respective co-operatives and improve their understanding on their roles;
- iii. undertake pre-entrepreneur training and capacity building so as to enable members to acquire new skills, sharpen existing ones, increase productivity and improve on management.

3.2.1.5 Economic empowerment indicator

While submitting on this question, the nominee defined the term “*Economic empowerment*” as the capacity of women and men to participate in, contribute to and benefit from growth processes in ways that recognize the value of their contributions, respect their dignity and make it possible to negotiate a fairer distribution of the benefits of growth.

On economic empowerment indicators, the nominee said he will undertake Monitoring and Evaluation since it is continuous management function to assess if progress is made in achieving the expected results.

CHAPTER FOUR

4.0 COMMITTEE OBSERVATIONS AND FINDINGS ON SUITABILITY OF THE NOMINEE

4.1 Mr. Stephen Makau Musili

Mr. Speaker Sir,

The Committee having considered the nominee's filled questionnaire, his curriculum vitae and his oral submissions during the approval hearing made the following observations on his suitability for appointment as the Chief Officer department of Trade, Industry, MSMEs and EIZs: **THAT: -**

1. In accordance with Article 78(1) and (2) of the Constitution, the nominee is eligible for appointment to a public office as he is a Kenyan citizen and does not hold dual citizenship.
2. The nominee holds a Bachelor of Arts Degree from The University of Nairobi, among other professional qualifications. He has over twenty-one (21) years of work experience having worked as the CEO- Kivunzi (K) Ltd, Member of County Assembly of Kitui, National Media Group among others. His academic credentials, professional training and experience comply with section 8 of the Public Appointment (County Assemblies) Approval Act.
3. The nominee meets the requirements of Chapter 6 of the Constitution on leadership and integrity having been cleared by all relevant government agencies.
4. The discrepancy in the order of nominee's academic certificates and national identity card was cured by the affidavit sworn in by the nominee dated 12th May, 2022 which was properly executed pursuant to the Oath and Declaration Act, declaring that the name **Stephen Makau Musili, Musili Makau,**

Musili Stephen Makau, Musili Stephen and **Stephen M. Musili** refers to the same person and that's him.

5. The nominee demonstrated knowledge of topical, administrative and technical issues touching on the County department and has the requisite abilities, qualifications and experience to serve as a Chief Officer in the county department to which he has been nominated as outlined below;

EDUCATION, TRAINING AND SKILLS DEVELOPMENT

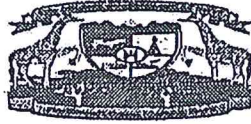

Following the advertisements for the positions of chief officers (CO's) by the Kitui County Public Service Board (CPSB) in the print media and website on 7th October, 2022 and 14th October, 2022 a total of 1,866 applications were received. A total of 208 applicants were shortlisted for the 26 posts with eight (8) persons shortlisted per position. Interviews were conducted from Wednesday November 23rd, 2022 to Friday December 9th, 2022.

After the conclusion of the interviews, the County Public Service Board submitted the names of the candidates as ranked for each post to the Office of the Governor on Tuesday December 13, 2022 to facilitate consideration for appointment of suitable and qualified candidates.

Please note four (4) current chief officers (COs) who were appointed in 2017/2018 by my predecessor H.E. Charity Kaluki Ngilu moved to court on 13th December 2022 alleging their appointments were on permanent and pensionable (P&P) basis and not contractual, among other prayers. The officers were granted conservatory orders by the Employment and Labour Relations Court (ELRC) thus restraining the Governor from appointing new chief officers to the four departments listed below or replacing them as COs until the case is heard and determined. The ex-parte orders were served to the Governors Office on Wednesday December 14, 2022.

The initial court order was extended by the ELRC during an interparties appearance on Monday December 19, 2022. I am advised the ELRC orders were also served to the County Assembly and I trust they have been availed to you. It is noteworthy the ELRC did not injunct the entire recruitment process as prayed by the four applicants/plaintiffs.

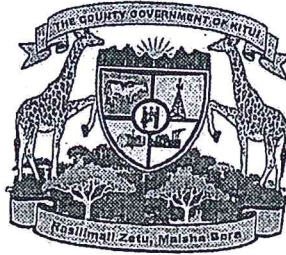

Your letter Ref: CAK/ADM/15/7/(44) dated 21st December, 2022 on the above refers. We wish to respond to the issues raised as follows:-

1. Rationale for the Post 2022 General Election Departmental Structure

The County Governor is obligated by law to ensure the structuring of the County Government after a General Election in a manner that will most effectively and efficiently deliver on the incoming government's vision and development agenda. This is the letter and spirit of section 30(2) (e) of the County Government Act, 2012.

The **twenty six (26)** departments under the reorganised county government structure were presented to the pre-election County Executive Committee and formed the basis of the Supplementary Budget I that the said County Executive Committee approved on **Wednesday October 19, 2022** and thus complying with the requirements of Section 46 of the County Governments Act, 2012.

It is noteworthy, the said Supplementary Budget I was subsequently forwarded to the County Assembly and was accordingly approved on **Wednesday November 30, 2022**. The **twelve (12)** ministries and **twenty six (26)** departments were part of the Governor's inaugural speech at the opening of the 3rd County Assembly delivered on the

11th October, 2022. Hence, the County Assembly was duly indulged on the matter, as necessary.

The Kitui County Public Service Board equally adopted and maintained the departments and proceeded to prepare advertisements for potential applicants to fill the subject chief officer positions in the **twenty six (26)** departments on the **7th and 14th October, 2022.**

2. Procedure used to arrive at the nominees including criteria for shortlisting

Following the advertisements for the positions of Chief Officers (CO's) by the Kitui County Public Service Board (CPSB) in the print media and website on **7th October, 2022** and **14th October, 2022** a total of **1,866** applications were received.

The County Public Service Board (CPSB) has advised my office that they were guided by the Constitutional Values and Principles in Article 10 and 232 of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010, and they used the following criteria to shortlist a total of 208 applicants for the **26** posts with **eight (8)** persons shortlisted per position:

- i. At least one candidate from each of the **Eight(8)** Sub Counties per position where applicable
- ii. At least one candidate from each of the **forty (40)** wards in all the positions where applicable
- iii. Meets the minimum qualifications and experience as per the advert
- iv. Representation of special groups such as Persons Living with Disability (PLWD), Women and Youth
- v. Regional balancing/ County diversity
- vi. Minorities

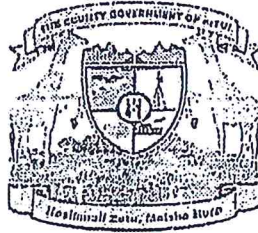

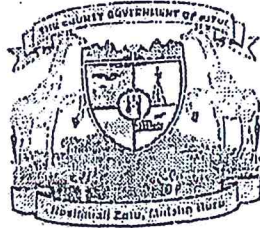

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 am. It started with a word of prayer by Mr. Joseph Kyavoa
The agenda was tabled and adopted.

MIN 1/6/10/2022 ADVERTISEMENT OF THE COUNTY CHIEF OFFICERS

The Board acknowledged receipt of a communication from the Executive on advertisement for sixteen (16) positions out of twenty six (26) positions of Chief Officers through letters Ref: CGKTI/OoG/HRM/VOL.2/4 (25) dated 4th October, 2022. However, the Board was notified that, the other ten (10) positions of Chief Officers were to be submitted for Board's deliberations and action. The Board deliberated on the sixteen (16) position to be advertised and made reference to the County Government Act No 17 of 2012 Section 46 (1) which states that; the county executive committee shall determine the organization of the county and its various departments, and for that purpose may—

- (a) establish, continue or vary any department, and determine the objects and purposes of the department;
- (b) determine the number and nature of departments at the decentralized units;
- (c) abolish any department; and
- (d) determine or change the name of any department.

Members deliberated further in reference to Article 46 (2) which states that; when establishing and organizing the county, the county executive committee shall take into account, and be guided by, the need to—

- (a) be responsive to the needs of the local community and the functions and competencies assigned to and transferred to the county;
- (b) facilitate a culture of public service and accountability in the county Public Service;
- (c) be performance oriented and focused on the objects of devolved government set out in Article 174 of the Constitution;
- (d) ensure that the county departments align their roles and responsibilities with the priorities and objectives set out in the county's policies and plans;
- (e) organize its departments and other structures in a flexible way in order to respond to changing priorities and circumstances;
- (f) assign clear responsibilities for the management and coordination of departments and functions;
- (g) allow participatory decision making as far as is practicable; and
- (h) provide an equitable, fair, open and non-discriminatory working environment.

The Board Concluded on this item and resolved that, the sixteen (16) departments proposed to be held by the incoming Chief Officers were not new offices in the County Public Service and did not require invoking the procedure provided for under section 62 of the County Government Act, 2012.

The Board finally resolved to advertise for the sixteen (16) positions to reach the widest coverage through the use of media and the County Website.

The Board deliberated on the issue of shortlisting and resolved that it will strive to promote in the County Public Service the values and principles referred to in Articles 10 and 232 of the Constitution of Kenya 2010. In compliance with the cited Articles the Board resolved that, the shortlisting of the County Chief Officers will be guided by the following Criteria;

- i) At least one candidate from each of the Eight (8) sub- Counties per position where applicable.

- ii) At least one candidate from each of the forty (40) wards in all the positions where applicable.
- iii) Meets minimum qualifications and experience as per the advert.
- iv) Representation of special groups (PLWD, Women, and Youth),
- v) Regional balancing/county diversity
- vi) Minorities


