

The Kitui Agricultural Show and Trade Fair is an important event aimed at promoting agricultural development, trade, and economic growth in Kitui County. The importance of agricultural shows and trade fairs cannot be overstated. They serve as catalysts for agricultural development by promoting knowledge sharing, encouraging technological advancements, and fostering collaboration among stakeholders. These events provide a

valuable opportunity for farmers to learn about new farming techniques, modern equipment, and best practices that can enhance productivity and sustainability. The Committee on Agriculture, water and irrigation raised concerns on the status, Preparedness and Budgetary Expenditure of the Kitui County Agricultural Show 2023, after the Committee noted that the said Agricultural Show and Trade Fair had been allocated a lot of funds in the Budget Estimates for the FYs 2022/2023 and 2023/2024 which had Kshs 10M and Kshs 23M respectively.

Following the Committee deliberations during the sectoral consideration of CIDP (2023-2027) at Mwingi, the Committee resolved to invite the County Executive Committee Member (CECM) for the County Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock *VIDE MIN.(AWI) 24/2023 KITUI COUNTY AGRICULTURAL SHOW AND TRADE FAIR 2023* to appear before the Committee on 7th July, 2023 to update the Committee on the preparedness of the Agricultural Show and trade fair.

Upon his submissions the Committee came up with the following key observations:

- a. The ministry of Agriculture and Livestock, through the Agricultural shows and Trade Fair will play a significant role in promoting agricultural development, fostering innovation, facilitating market access, creating business networks and partnerships in all Economic sectors.

- b. Kitui County Agricultural Show and Trade Fair will serve as a source of Revenue and have economic impact for the county, exhibitors and also provide employment opportunities for the people who will be participating in different roles during the Show.

Inclusion the committee came up with the following recommendations for implementation by the Ministry:
The Committee Recommended that:


- a. The Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock to consider having Mwingi and Mutomo Agricultural Show with a view of creating opportunities for farmers, agribusinesses and agricultural enterprises to showcase and market their products and services.

- b. The Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock through the agriculture extension officers should capacity build farmers in the County to adopt modern methods of farming that involves biotech agriculture or Agri-tech (a technique in agriculture that involves scientific tool & techniques, including genetic engineering, molecular markers, molecular diagnostics, vaccines, and tissue culture to modify a living organism; plants, animals and microorganisms).

c. That the County Ministry should sensitize and educate farmers in the County on the importance of value addition to their agricultural products. This should be done through organizing seminars at the Ward or Village level to train farmers on how they can transform raw agricultural products into a new product through packaging, processing, cooling, drying, extracting or any other type of process that differentiates the product from the original raw product.

d. The Committee recommends that the County Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock in consultation with the Members of County Assembly to identify at least 5 farmers from each ward and facilitate them to attend the Agricultural show as a way of promoting and creating awareness on the emerging new farming technologies.

The importance of agricultural shows and trade fairs cannot be overstated. They serve as catalysts for agricultural development by promoting knowledge sharing, encouraging technological advancements, and fostering collaboration among stakeholders. These events provide a valuable opportunity for farmers to learn about new farming techniques, modern equipment, and best practices that can enhance productivity and sustainability.

Mr. Speaker Sir,

In Kenya, the Agricultural Society of Kenya (ASK) plays a significant role in organizing and facilitating agricultural shows and trade fairs. ASK, as the country's premier agricultural organization, has been instrumental in promoting and advancing the agricultural sector through its various activities and events. Although, Agricultural Society of Kenya (ASK), being the prominent organization in promoting agriculture and trade in Kenya, it does not extend its coverage to all counties within the country. Nevertheless, recognizing the significance of agricultural shows and trade fairs, specific counties have taken the initiative to revitalize and establish their own agricultural shows and Trade Fairs.

2.0 BACKGROUND

Mr. Speaker Sir,

The Committee on Agriculture, water and Irrigation raised concerns on the status, Preparedness and Budgetary Expenditure of the Kitui County Agricultural Show 2023, after the Committee noted that the said Agricultural Show and Trade Fair had been allocated huge funds in the Budget Estimates for the FYs 2022/2023 and 2023/2024 which had Kshs 10M and Kshs 23M respectively totalling to 33M.

Following the Committee deliberations during the sectoral consideration of CIDP (2023-2027) at Mwingi, the Committee resolved to invite the County Executive Committee Member (CECM) for the County Ministry of

Agriculture and Livestock *VIDE MIN.(AWI) 24/2023 KITUI COUNTY AGRICULTURAL SHOW AND TRADE FAIR 2023* to appear before the Committee on 7th July, 2023 to update the Committee concerning the Agricultural Show.

2.1 OBJECTIVE OF THE AGRICULTURAL SHOW AND TRADE FAIR, 2023.

Mr. Speaker Sir,

The Kitui Agricultural Show and Trade Fair 2023 will play a significant role in promoting agricultural development, fostering innovation, facilitating market access, creating networks and partnerships in the agricultural sector.

The specific objectives are to:

- i) Showcase and promote the latest technologies and practices in the agricultural sector by highlighting innovations in farming techniques, crop varieties, animal husbandry, agricultural machinery, geared towards increasing agricultural production and productivity.
- ii) Facilitate Knowledge Exchange. The show will provide a platform for farmers, researchers, industry experts and other stakeholders to exchange knowledge, ideas and best practices.
- iii) Market Agricultural Products-the show will create opportunities for farmers, agribusinesses and agricultural enterprises to showcase and market their products and services.
- iv) Foster networking and collaboration among various stakeholders in the agricultural sector. It will bring together farmers, agribusinesses, government agencies, research institutions, financial institutions and industry experts thus facilitate partnerships and collaborations
- v) Educate the public about the importance of agriculture, food production and sustainability. It will raise awareness about agricultural challenges, climate change, resource management and promote the adoption of environmentally friendly and sustainable practices.
- vi) develop participants' skills through training sessions, demonstrations, and improve their productivity and income.

6.0 SUBMISSIONS BY THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEMBER FOR THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE AND LIVESTOCK.

Mr. Speaker Sir,
The County Executive Member (CECM) for the County Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock informed the Committee that the forthcoming Kitui County Agricultural Show and Trade Fair, will be held as from 27th -29th July, 2023 at Ithookwe Showground Kitui. The official opening day by His Excellency Kitui County Governor Dr Julius Malombe, EGH, will be on 28th July, 2023.

The theme of the Agricultural Show will be "*Promoting Climate Smart Agriculture and Trade Initiatives for Sustainable Food and Nutrition Security and Economic Growth.*"

6.1 PREPAREDNESS ON HOSTING THE KITUI COUNTY AGRICULTURAL SHOW AND TRADE FAIR, 2023.

Mr. Speaker Sir,

Organizing agricultural shows and trade fairs involves a range of activities to ensure a successful and well-coordinated event. The key activities the Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock has undertaken in preparation for the Kitui Agricultural Show and Trade Fair are as follows: -

a. Establishment of Show Planning and Organizing Committee

The show planning and organizing committee consists of representatives from County Ministries and Departments, Non-governmental organizations, National Government Ministries, Departments and Agencies (MDAs), Media, Farming and business community.

A total of six (6) subcommittees have been established each focusing on specific aspects. These subcommittees include:

- a) Trade, finance and stand allocation sub-committee;
- b) Publicity, Branding and marketing sub-committee;
- c) Security and environment sub-committee;
- d) Protocol and Entertainment sub-committee;
- e) Exhibits and exhibition sub-committee and

f) Judging and awards sub-committee.

b. Invitation of Exhibitors and Show Participants

The sub-committee on Exhibits and exhibition has identified a total of 348 potential exhibitors and invited them to participate in the event. These exhibitors include:

- Companies such as Agrochemical & seed companies, information technology, services, processing and manufacturing.
- Media houses.
- Government Ministries, Departments and Agencies (MDAs)
- Argo-shops.
- Farmer organizations – Self-Help groups, Community Based organizations (CBOs) and farmer Cooperatives.
- Financial institutions – Banks, Microfinances and Savings and Credit Cooperatives SACCOs.
- Tertiary institutions - universities, colleges, institutes, vocational schools and polytechnics.
- Non-governmental Organisations.
- Private health service providers.

Mr. Speaker Sir,

A total of 49 exhibitors have so far confirmed to participate. Furthermore, invitations have been extended to the general public, including show participants, through various channels such as press releases, talk shows, and social media platforms. This will ensure widespread awareness and participation in the Kitui Agricultural Show and Trade Fair 2023.

Mr. Speaker Sir,

Secondary and Primary schools in the county have been reached out through the County Director of Education. This will expose and educate learners about the importance of agriculture, sustainable practices, and the opportunities in the agricultural sector.

To prepare the Kitui Agricultural Show and Trade Fair, a budget of Kshs. 11,000,000 was allocated during the 2022/2023 financial year and Kshs. 23,000,000 during the 2023/2024 financial year. Funds for 2022/2023 financial year have been utilized for the initial planning and preparatory activities as detailed in the table below.

6.2 BUDGETARY EXPENDITURE FOR THE AGRICULTURAL SHOW AND TRADE FAIR 2023.
Mr. Speaker Sir,

Adequate measures for safety, security, and accessibility are being put in place in collaboration with National Police Service (NPS) and County Enforcement. A physical plan for the showground has been developed. Provisions for hotel spaces to offer catering services for exhibitors and participants has been considered in the show physical plan. First aid facilities and services will be provided by the County Ministry of Health and Sanitation in collaboration with Kenya Red Cross Society (KRCS), Kitui Branch.

e. Security, Logistics and Operations

The ministry of Agriculture and livestock has established a model demonstration farm to showcase various climate smart agricultural technologies. The Agricultural demonstration plots are ready and well maintained.

d. Agricultural demonstration plots

The necessary infrastructure and facilities are being set up at Ithookwe show ground to prepare for the event. This includes rehabilitation of the gates, perimeter fence, solar floodlights, arena, buildings and sanitation facilities. The road leading to the show grounds has been upgraded to bituminous standards while the exit road below St Ursula Girls Secondary School is being cleared and graded by the county department for roads and public works.





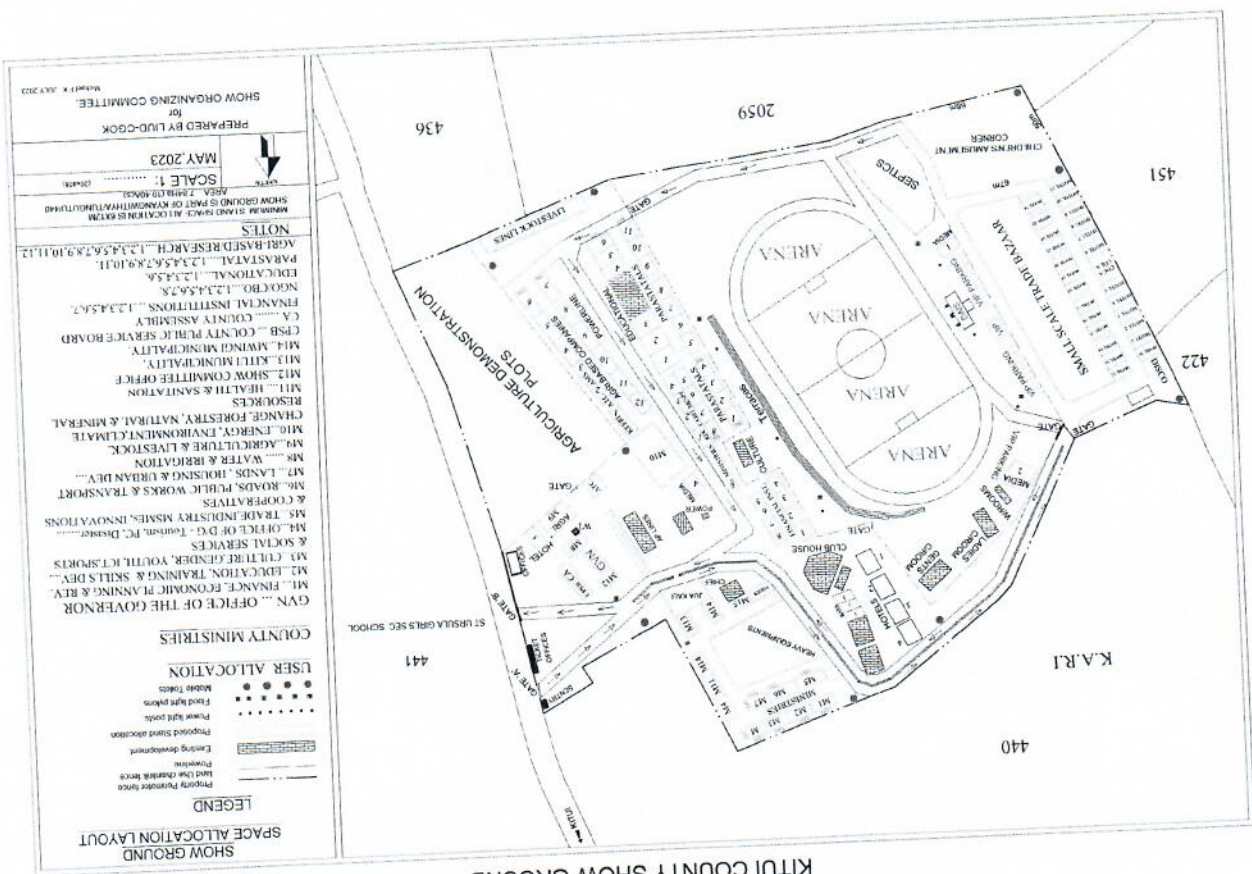
