**9.\*. MOTION ON APPROVAL OF THE MODEL INTERGOVERNMENTAL  
CONDITIONAL ALLOCATION AGREEMENT - (Leader of the Majority Party).**

**AWARE** that Article 189 of the Constitution provides for cooperation between national and county governments;

**FURTHER AWARE THAT** section 191A of the Public Finance Management Act provides for inter-governmental agreements whereby the National Treasury shall enter into agreements with the respective County Governments for the transfer of the respective Conditional Additional Allocation made to the County Government under the Act;

**NOTING THAT** the National Treasury in conjunction with other stakeholders such as the Controller of Budget, Council of Governors, Commission on Revenue Allocation, etc, came up with the model Intergovernmental Conditional Allocations Transfer Agreement between the National Government and the Counties, indicating how funds for various programmes will be sourced and released from the National Government in the current financial year;

**FURTHER NOTING THAT** Council of Governors forwarded the model Agreement to all County Executive Committee Members (CECMs) responsible for Finance, through the County Governors, considering that the model has incorporated comments by the Attorney General and has been cleared for implementation by County Governments;

**FURTHER AWARE** that the CECM for Finance and Economic Planning conducted public participation on the model agreement pursuant to Section 191B of the PFM Act at KEFRI Centre, Kitui Town.
