# THE KITUI COUNTY ALCOHOLIC DRINKS CONTROL (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2024 (COUNTY ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 3 OF 2024)

Notice is given that the Chairperson of the Committee on Administration and Coordination of County Affairs intends to move for approval by the House the following clauses to the Kitui County Alcoholic Drinks Control (Amendment) Bill, 2024 (County Assembly Bill No. 3 of 2024)

#### **CLAUSES WITHOUT AMENDMENTS**

Clauses 4,5,6,8,9,10,11,12,13,14,15,16,17,18,19,20,22 and 23

**THAT,** Clauses 4,5,6,8,9,10,11,12,13,14,15,16,17,18,19,20,22,23 as printed be part of the Bill.

#### **CLAUSES WITH AMENDMENTS**

#### CLAUSE 2

THAT, Clause 2 of the Bill be amended in paragraph 2(b) as follows;

- i. By deleting the word "pharse" and replacing with the word "phrase".
- ii. By deleting the word "enforcent" and replacing with the word "enforcement"

#### **CLAUSE 3**

THAT, Clause 3 of the Bill be amended as follows;

The new proposed Section 4A: -

#### Subsection (1)(g)

by inserting the word "by" between the word "appointed" and the words "the Executive Member" and further by inserting the words "for a term of three years and shall be eligible for reappointment for one further term" immediately after the word "Member" and before the semicolon.

#### Subsection (1)(h)

by inserting the words "for a term of three years and shall be eligible for reappointment for one further term" immediately after the word "Member" and before the semicolon.

#### **Subsection 7**

By deleting in entirety all the words contained in Subsection 7 and replacing them thereof with the following;

- (7) A vacancy in the positions under Subsection (1) (a) (g) and (h) may arise where a member;
  - Is adjudged bankrupt;
  - ii. Resigns in writing to the appointing authority;
  - iii. Is convicted of a crime and sentenced to imprisonment;
  - iv. Is unable to perform the functions of the office by reason of infirmity or prolonged illness;
  - v. Is of unsound mind;
  - vi. Dies; or
  - vii. Is absent from at least 5 consecutive meetings without any justifiable reason or without prior permission from the appointing authority.

#### **New Sub Section 2**

By inserting a new Subsection 2 immediately after Sub-section 1 as follows; New Sub Section 2

- (2) A person shall be eligible for appointment as the Chairperson of the Committee if that person;
  - Possesses a university degree in a relevant field from a university recognized in Kenya;
  - ii. Has knowledge and experience of at least five (5) years in a relevant field;

iii. Meets the requirements of Chapter 6 of the Constitution.

#### **New Sub Section (11)**

By inserting a new Subsection 11 immediately after Subsection 10 as follows; (11) The reports under Sub Section 10 shall be submitted to the County Assembly within twenty-eight (28) days upon submission to the Executive Member.

#### **Renumbering new Section 4A**

By renumbering new Section 4A to conform to the legislative drafting guidelines.

#### **CLAUSE 7**

THAT, Clause 7 of the Bill be amended as follows: -

#### **New Subclause 3**

By inserting a new Subclause 3

- (3) A vacancy in the positions under Sub-Clause (2) (D) may arise where a member;
  - i. Is adjudged bankrupt;
  - ii. Resigns in writing to the appointing authority;
  - iii. Is convicted of a crime and sentenced to imprisonment
  - iv. Is unable to perform the functions of the office by reason of infirmity or prolonged illness;
  - v. Is of unsound mind;
  - vi. Dies; or
  - vii. Is absent from at least four (4) consecutive meetings without any justifiable reason or without prior permission from the appointing authority.

By renumbering Section 7 to conform to the legislative drafting guidelines.
