

STATEMENT REQUEST ON THE NON-OPERATIONALIZATION OF THITANI MORTUARY IN KYOME THAANA WARD IN KYOME THAANA WARD

Mr. Speaker Sir,

Pursuant to the provisions of Standing Order No. 41 (2) (c), I wish to request a statement from the Chairperson of the Committee on Health and Sanitation regarding the non-operationalization of Thitani Mortuary in Kyome Thaana Ward.

Whether the Chairperson is aware that despite Thitani Mortuary in Kyome Thaana Ward being completed and equipped over two years ago, the facility remains non-operational up to date.

That the continued non-operationalization of the mortuary has caused considerable hardship for the residents of Kyome Thaana Ward and neighboring areas. Bereaved families are compelled to seek mortuary services from distant locations, resulting in logistical challenges, emotional distress, and increased financial burdens.

Whether the Chairperson is aware of the provisions of Article 201(d) of the Constitution which stipulates that public funds shall be used prudently and responsibly to avoid wastage. Therefore, the prolonged non-operationalization of the mortuary constitutes both lack of value for public money and imprudent utilization of resources.

I therefore request the Committee on Health and Sanitation to provide a statement response within twenty-one (21) days. Specifically, I urge the Committee to:
