**COMMUNICATION FROM THE CHAIR AS RELATES TO THE
KITUI COUNTY FISCAL STRATEGY PAPER, (CFSP) 2025/2026.**

Honourable Members.

Article 224 of the Constitution of Kenya 2010, provides that every County Government shall prepare and adopt its own Annual Budget and Appropriation Bill in the form, and according to the procedure prescribed in an Act of Parliament.

Thus, the County Governments are specifically guided by Part IV (four) of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012 that touches on

County Government responsibilities with respect to Management and Control of Public Finance.

Honourable Members.

The Public Finance Management Act, 2012 outlines the procedures to be followed and the relevant statutory instruments required to be passed in approving the County Annual Budget.

The County Fiscal Strategy Paper is one of the Statutory Documents as envisaged above and provided for in Section 117 of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012 that inter alia states that: -

...the County Treasury shall prepare and submit to the County Executive Committee the County Fiscal Strategy Paper for approval and the County Treasury shall submit the approved Fiscal Strategy Paper to the County Assembly, by the 28th February of each year.

It is for this reason therefore that the County Executive Member for Finance, Economic Planning and Revenue Management submitted to the County Assembly on Friday the 28th February, 2025 the County Fiscal Strategy Paper for the Financial Year 2025/2026 for approval.

Honourable Members,

As guided by the provisions of Standing Order 205, I hereby commit this Fiscal Strategy Paper to the Sectoral Committees to deliberate upon as per their respective mandate and subsequently make recommendations to the County Budget and Appropriations Committee.

The County Budget and Appropriations Committee shall thereupon consolidate and table a report together with its recommendations to the County Assembly for consideration.

COMMUNICATION AS RELATES TO THE COUNTY MEDIUM TERM DEBT MANAGEMENT STRATEGY, 2025.

Honourable Members,

County Governments are specifically guided by part 4 (four) of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012, that touches on County Government Responsibilities with respect to the management and control of Public Finance.

Honourable Members,

The Public Finance Management Act, 2012 outlines the procedures to be followed and the relevant statutory instruments required to be passed in approving the County annual Budget.

It is for this reason therefore that the County Executive Committee Member for Finance, Economic Planning and Revenue Management

submitted to the Assembly on Friday the 28th February, 2025 the County Medium Term Debt Management Strategy, 2025. This is in compliance with the provisions of section 123 of the Public Finance Management Act which provides that

On or before the 28th February in each year, the County Treasury shall submit to the county assembly a statement setting out the debt management strategy of the county government over the medium term with regard to its actual liability and potential liability in respect of loans and its plans for dealing with those liabilities.

The County Treasury shall include the following information in the statement: -

- a) The total stock of debt as at the date of the statement;
- b) The sources of loans made to the county government;
- c) The principal risks associated with those loans;
- d) The assumptions underlying the debt management strategy; and
- e) An analysis of the sustainability of the amount of debt, both actual and potential.

Honourable members,

Section 123 (3) of the Public Finance Management Act provides that as soon as practicable after the statement has been submitted to the county assembly under this section, the County Executive

Committee member for finance shall publish and publicize the statement and submit a copy to the Commission on Revenue Allocation and the Intergovernmental Budget and Economic Council.

Honourable Members,

Section 141(2) of the Public Finance Management Act provides that a County Government may borrow money in accordance with the Act but shall not exceed the limit set by the County Assembly.

Therefore, I hereby commit this County Medium Term Debt Management Strategy, 2025 to the County Budget and Appropriations Committee for consideration and subsequently table a report together with its recommendations to the County Assembly.

**COMMUNICATION AS RELATES TO COURT ORDER ISSUING
CONSERVATORY ORDERS ON SELECT AND SECTORAL
COMMITTEES.**

Honourable Members,

On 4th March 2025, the County Assembly received a Court Order dated 3rd March 2025, issued by the High Court of Kenya at Kitui in Constitutional Petition No. HCCHRPF/E001/2025. The Order grants conservatory measures suspending the reconstitution of Select and Sectoral Committees, which had been reconstituted on 14th February, 2025. The Honourable Speaker, the Acting Clerk of Assembly and the Leader of the Majority Party have been named as respondents in this petition.

Following receipt of this Court Order, I sought legal advice from the legal department through the Office of the Clerk on the appropriate course of action. I now present the legal guidance as received. "I hereby provide my considered legal opinion on the Petition as follows:

A. Facts

Hon. Mark K. Nding'o & Thirty-Four Others filed Constitutional Petition No. E001/2025 in the High Court of Kitui, seeking the following interim reliefs:

1. **Conservatory Orders** suspending the reconstituted Kitui County Assembly Select and Sectoral Committees, which were established through a resolution of the House on 14th February 2025.

2. **Restraining Orders** preventing the said committees from conducting sittings, incurring expenditures in terms of allowances or other means, or performing any functions under the County Assembly Standing Orders.

B. Issue

What are the legal implications of the conservatory orders issued by the High Court?

C. Analysis

The conservatory orders have significant legal and operational implications. Of particular concern is the impact on statutory committees such as the **Committee on Budget and Appropriations**, the **Committee on Public Investments and Accounts** and the **Committee on Finance and Planning**. These committees are mandated by law to review and recommend for approval of these statutory documents to the Assembly within specific timelines, including but not limited to:

- **The County Fiscal Strategy Paper.**
- **The County Annual and Supplementary Budgets together with Appropriation Bills.**

- **The Annual Development Plan**
- **The Auditor General Reports**

The issuance of the conservatory orders effectively stalls the operations of these committees. Consequently, their inability to discharge their statutory mandates within the prescribed timelines may have detrimental effects on governance and service delivery within the County Assembly, ultimately affecting common people.

Honourable Members,

In light of the legal advice received and in relation to my earlier communication committing the County Fiscal Strategy Paper (CFSF), the Debt Management Strategy Paper (DMSF) for the Financial Year 2025/2026, and the Auditor General's Report to the County Budget and Appropriations, and the Public Investments and Accounts Committees respectively, I wish to direct as follows:

1. Consideration of these vital documents shall be deferred pending either:

- The lifting of the Court Orders, or
- The Court's ruling on the matter, whichever comes first.

2. The Assembly will expeditiously pursue legal recourse to seek the vacation of the Court Orders to allow statutory committees to proceed with their functions.

3. Until the conservatory orders are lifted or the case is determined, the affected committees are prohibited from undertaking any activities related to these documents.

Honourable Members,

The Assembly remains committed to upholding the rule of law while ensuring effective legislative oversight and service delivery to the people of Kitui. I will keep the House informed of any developments regarding this matter.
